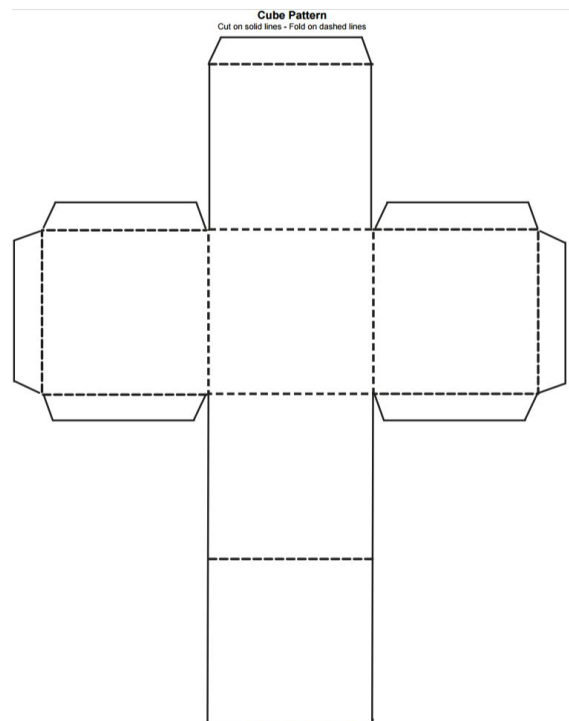
The Influence of the Islamic Culture Cube Project

16 points

Learning Target: Describe how the Islamic culture and its achievements influenced the Mediterranean region.

Task: Using the template, you and your partner are required to create a cube of illustrations and information over six areas (3 per partner) of Muslim achievement that influenced the Mediterranean region.

1. *Research your three chosen topics and write down useful information that will help in understanding your topic. You must include enough details to fill four sides of your cube.*
2. *Decide what two pictures you would like to draw to represent your chosen topic. Your pictures will fill in the remaining two sides of your cube*
3. *Create your cube by adding detailed information on four(4) sides of the cube and FULL COLOR pictures on the two(2) remaining sides of the cube.*
4. *Cut out the cube, fold it along the dotted lines, and glue or tape it together. Attach yarn to each cube so it can be hung from a hanger or rod for display.*
