### SUMMER SCHOOL GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Summer Health will involve two components:
  - 1. Online curriculum
  - CPR-related discussion/activities administered from a certified professional and tentatively presentations from The Stark County Domestic Violence Project. These sessions will take place June 11<sup>th</sup> – June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Students are required to attend summer school session times from June 11<sup>th</sup> – June 29<sup>th</sup> from 8:00-11:30. If they complete the course prior to June 29<sup>th</sup>, they will be released early.
- Courses will be closed at the end of the session and all work will be voided if the coursework is not completed.
- A support teacher will be available to assist with technology and some course content, but the online program offers comprehensive tutorials which should provide the student with adequate information and materials to be successful.
- Students will be provided a schoolissued laptop to utilize during the summer school session. Please review the Financial Responsibility Notice on the back page of this brochure.

### Grades:

At the conclusion of summer school, a grade report will be sent to the student's school counselor to be transcripted into the student's academic records in the Fall.

#### Attendance:

All courses meet Monday through Friday on the dates listed. Students are expected to be prompt to class. Due to the concentrated nature of the summer school curriculum. regular dailv attendance is a "MUST." If absent for more than two days of summer school, the student may be removed from summer school with NO course credit or refund of registration fees. If absent, upon returning the student must bring in a signed excuse. If special circumstances regarding attendance arise, a meeting must be scheduled with Mr. Clark.

### Tardies:

If tardy more than 20 minutes to class, it will be considered an absence. After two tardies to class, the student may be removed from the summer school session with no course credit or refund of registration fees.

### **Dress/Behavior Code:**

Students are expected to abide by the Canton Local District dress and behavior codes. Failure to abide by the regulations may result in removal from the course and forfeiture of fees.
